Subject: Payment of Ex-Gratia Lump Sum compensation to Defence Service Officers and Personnel Below Officer Rank who are invalided out of service on account of Disability attributable to or aggravated by Military Service.

A copy of GOI MOD letter No 2(2)/2011/D (Pen/Pol) dated 26 Dec 2011 regarding payment of Ex-Gratia Lump Sum compensation to Defence Service officers and personnel below officer rank who are invalided out of service on account of disability attributable to or aggravated by military service has been forwarded for necessary action at your end vide this office Circular No 477 dated 07.02.2012.

Ex-Gratia Lump sum compensation amounting to Rs 9 lakhs for 100% disability but not less than 20 % shall be paid to those Defence Personnel who are disabled/incapacitated in performance of their bonafide official duties under various circumstances and are boarded out from service on or after 01.04.2011 on account of Disability/war injury attributable to or aggravated by Military Service.

It has been further clarified by MOD vide MOD ID No 2(2) /2011-D(Pen/POI) dated 5th October 2012 (Copy Enclosed) that above :

(i)Ex-gratia lump sum compensation is in addition to other Pensionary benefits, and,

(ii)Ex-gratia compensation is payable to such personnel who are boarded out of service on account of **permanent disability** assessed at 20% or more by the Medical Board.

In view of the above, you are requested to submit/re-submit all affected cases to O I/C G-3 Section of this office along with the statement of the case with all supporting documents as mentioned in this office circular no 477 dated 07.02.2012.

All other instructions and conditions remain unchanged as already circulated by this office circular No 477 dated 07.02.2012. All effective cases may be sent to this office on **“TOP PRIORITY”**
